### APPEAL FOR HELP

We are hiring a number of set pieces for Peter Pan which will arrive at Motherwell Concert Hall on Friday 27<sup>th</sup> January at 10.00am. ### TECHNICAL REHEARSAL: Sunday 29<sup>th</sup> January

Our technical rehearsal is on **Sunday 29<sup>th</sup> January** in **Motherwell Concert Hall, Civic Centre, Windmillhill Street, Motherwell, ML1 1AB.**

This is a long rehearsal for all cast and crew (times below), the purpose of which is to ensure that everyone learns the workings of the show with the set, props, costumes, lighting and sound. Peter Pan is a technically complex production with lots of moving scenery, flying and other special effects. A great amount of patience is required as the rehearsal will stop regularly to allow the stage management team to rehearse each scene.

Cast members should adhere to the following:

- Enter the Concert Hall via Main Entrance – register upon arrival. You will then be shown to your dressing room where you can unpack your costumes and wait to be called to the stage.
- All cast must arrive 10 minutes before their scheduled rehearsal time
- Long hair must be tied up
- No make up to be worn (only stage make-up which will be applied)
- No fake tan
- All jewellery must be removed prior to arrival
- White underwear should be worn (unless told otherwise)
- Wear shorts and vest tops under costumes
- Correct footwear for all scenes must be worn and should have names marked in side
- Costumes must be on a hanger and should be ironed if necessary
- Dressing rooms must be kept tidy and own costumes organised respectfully.

Rehearsals times for Sunday 29<sup>th</sup> January are as follows:

- **9.00am-10.00am** Technical Team ONLY
- **10.00am-12.00pm** Main Cast arrive for sound check
- **11.30am – 4.00 pm** **Act One Technical Rehearsal** FULL CAST  
(including BOTH Kids Teams)
- **4.00pm** Shine Kids: Jolly Roger Rascals to be collected
- **4.00pm-5.00pm** Dinner Break (all cast must bring a packed dinner)
- **6.00pm** Shine Kids Neverland Numpties to be collected
- **5.00pm-9.00pm** **Act Two Technical Rehearsal**
- **9.30pm approximately** Cast finish/Pick up  
(parents please collect young people from concert hall auditorium)

## **DRESS REHEARSAL: Monday 30<sup>th</sup> January**

**Monday 30<sup>th</sup> January** is our Dress Rehearsal, this rehearsal should run as if it is the first night of the show.

- **5.00pm** Main cast arrive for sound check
- **6.00pm** Full cast to arrive and proceed to dressing rooms (including Shine Kids: Jolly Roger Rascals)
- **10.00pm** Finish time

The dress rehearsal will finish at approximately 10.00pm. Parents are asked to collect young people from the concert hall auditorium.

## **PERFORMANCE NIGHTS**

The show will finish at approximately 10.00pm each evening, however we will not know for sure until the first performance.

- **5.00pm** Main cast arrive for sound check
- **6.00pm** Full cast to arrive (proceed to dressing rooms)
- **10.00pm** Approximate finish time

Members of the cast may leave costumes in the dressing rooms each evening. Shine Kids should take their jumper and shoes home. No parents are allowed in the dressing rooms during the show unless chaperoning – this includes the interval. Parents /carers should collect young people from the concert hall foyer at the end of the performance.
